Get Ready for Middle School

Children who were born on or after Jan. 1, 2002, who are attending 7th grade or who are new entrants to a Georgia school in grades 8 through 12 must have received one dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine and one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine.

Proof of both vaccinations must be documented on the Georgia Immunization Certificate (form 3231), and certified by a licensed Georgia healthcare provider or health center official. The DeKalb County Board of Health has all the forms required to enroll your child in school at their health center locations.

The DeKalb County Board of Health offers the following services:

- Childhood immunizations
- Hearing, vision, nutrition, and dental screenings (form 3300)
- Birth certificates for children born in Georgia
- Sports physicals

Payment for clinical services may be made by cash, debit/credit card or a check from a Georgia bank. Clients with Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids are welcome. Also, Aetna and State Health Benefits Plan (Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Georgia) coverage are accepted. Other insurances may be acceptable, if verified.

Birth certificates for children born in Georgia are available from Vital Records in the Eleanor Richardson Health Center. Payment for birth certificates may be made by cash or debit/credit card only.
